Dr. Castillo is the Clinical Director of the Bing Center for Waldenstrom's Macroglobulinemia at Dana Farber, and sees approx 1000 WM patients/year in his Boston clinic. He is also the principal investigator in a series of clinical trials evaluating new treatments for WM.
